Dear brothers in Christ

Once again it is a pleasure to greet you hoping that each one of you is in good health. In this month of January, we had a very difficult month because the biggest wave of Covid hit our city in such a way that 60% of the church was infected with both Covid and the flu, and this led us to take precautionary measures. To help break the chains of contagion and thus protect our members, we had to close the building for the last three weeks of January and return to Facebook Live broadcasts. My wife and I also tested positive for Covid during the month of January, I was asymptomatic, but my wife was sicker suffering all the symptoms, headache, bone and back pain, sore throat, and lost her sense of smell and taste. At the hospital she had x-rays to check her lungs, thank God her lungs were clear, and her oxygen levels were normal. The two doses of vaccines against Covid that we applied six months ago did their job because thank God that none of our members got seriously ill and we are now fully recovered, as well as the rest of the brotherhood, they are all well. But I also want to inform you that throughout the quarantine we were in contact with our members by phone and messages praying for each other and providing help to those who needed it.

By the way, one of our elders from the church named Francisco Enciso came to cook vegetable and fish broths to take to the homes of our sick brothers. This was a great service that he offered freely, and we received him, we are very grateful for his generosity and service.

But already this Sunday, February 6, we began to meet in person with a capacity of 30% of its capacity as ordered by law, with the following strategy, all families with young people and old people met in the morning and all families with children in the afternoon service, we will be doing it this way for the remainder of the month of February.

On February 14 we had planned our first local marriage meeting, but we decided to cancel it because the attendance exceeds the capacity allowed but it is likely that we will broadcast it via Google meet. We are also very grateful that you continue to support us as we are eager to work freely and without the limitations of the pandemic, but we know that God is in control.
