Once again it gives me great pleasure to greet you and let you know about the work of the Lord in Zaragoza.

Thank God, we are already working without restrictions due to the pandemic, and if we continue like this, we will be resuming all our activities that we have planned for this year 2022, such as the following: an evangelistic campaign in June and the VBS in July and soon a youth meeting. Also, our ministries are working almost 100% in our local congregation, such as evangelism, singing, teaching, fellowships. And we also give participation in some small ministry to each member or family of our congregation. We are considering the possibility of resuming home meetings as this area brings us even closer to our members.

We already started Mr. Freddy Valdez and he responded to the gospel by being baptized for the forgiveness of sins, his wife Guadalupe Valdez has not yet been baptized but she is positive about the gospel. We have also finished evangelizing Mrs. Rosy who after four studies did not respond to her invitation, we only thanked her for her attention.

Attendance at our Sunday morning meetings averages 90 including children. Regarding the teaching of the Bible class for adults on Sundays, I am presenting a series called THE BIBLICAL CHURCH. I am exposing these studies since we have had some visitors to know the church of Christ. As for the sermons, I am presenting a series based on Colossians 3:18-4:1 called DO IT HEARTILY, AS TO THE LORD do, With the following topics: 1. IN MARRIAGE Ver. 18-19; 2. IN THE PATERNAL Ver. 20-21; 3. AT LABOR Ver. 22-4:1

In Wednesday Bible class we are still studying THE UNITY OF THE SPIRIT Ephesians 4:1-6

I also want to inform you that I have my appointment for my passport at the Consulate for May 25, in fact I had it until August but thank God it was brought forward. So now that I have my passport, I could make a plan to visit you. Thank you for the support may God multiply your blessings.
